HYACKS DOMINATE SEASON OPENER

It didn't take long for the Hyacks offense to get going this season as they scored on their first two offensive plays, en route to a 56-7 win over Pinetree. **Blain Cawkell** rushed for 105 yards and 2 TDs on just 5 carries. Every player saw action as the Hyacks used 11 different ball carriers and rushed for

421 yards and 8 TDs. **Brent Fletcher** also scored twice on his first two carries, while **Enoch Osei**, **Aaron Purdey**, **Torsten Jaccard** and **Milton Nevy** each scored once.

Defensively the Hyacks starting unit didn't allow a first down in just over one quarter of action.

Casey Chin recorded 5 tackles including 2 for loss in limited playing time. Gurdas Panesar took advantage of the added playing time with 5 tackles of his own including a QB sack. Shiraz Chaudhary got the defense going with an interception on Pinetree's first possession.



A crowd of over 500 was on hand for the game and they were treated to a beautiful night, a halftime concert and a solid performance by the home team. The Ravens are the two-time defending provincial champion, so the result bodes well for a Hyack team looking to gain experience and improve over the course of the season. Next up will be the Handsworth Royals in the first home game of the season for the Hyacks. Kickoff is this Thursday at 5:30 pm at Mercer Stadium.

The Hyacks visited the White Rock South Surrey Titans on a sunny Sunday afternoon, unfortunately losing 32-0. Standouts on offense were Mackenzie Ratcliffe, Dylan Sharpe and Eric Phillips. Defensively, the Hyacks were led by Prem Hoonjan, Nolan Duncan and Sequoyah Good. Enzo Gentile boomed some big punts on special teams, pushing the Titans back after several stalled drives.
