High School News & Notes

HYACKS FINISH PRE-SEASON AT 3-1



The Hyacks suffered their first loss of the season, 49-14 against an outstanding opponent, Terry Fox, the number one ranked team in the province. The Ravens took a 14-0 lead in the first quarter, before the Hyacks made it 28-14 late in the 2nd. **Blain Cawkell** and **Abdul Ali** scored New West's TDs, before Terry Fox regained control in the 3rd quarter. Cawkell finished the game with 94 yards rushing and is currently 5th in the province with 447 yards

this season.

Defensively the Hyacks were led by **Casey Chin** (9 tackles), **Marko Susic** (8 tackles, 1 int) and **Vivie Bojilov** (7 tackles). Chin ranks 4th in BC in tackles with 29 while Bojilov is 9th with 24. The loss drops the Hyacks record to 3-1 in non-conference play and they are now ranked 5th in BC.

IRISH INVADE MERCER IN SEASON OPENER

The Hyacks will open up the regular season this Friday night, when Vancouver College, visits Mercer Stadium at 7:30 pm. The Irish moved past the Hyacks in the provincial rankings after a 40-33 win at Rutland last Friday night. VC is also 3-1 and defeated the Hyacks 28-19 last season at O'Hagen Field. That game was the first ever meeting between the two programs at the varsity level. The Irish have traditionall been one of the top programs in BC, having reached the Subway Bowl finals in 4 of the past 6 seasons. They will be led by RB Garret Sanvido who sits 4th in BC with 574 rushing yards, TE/DE Cody Rossi and LBs Francesco Renzullo and Lucas Cordick.
