HYACKS WIN THRILLER IN HOME OPENER

It was billed as the first Clash of the Titans in BC High School Football circles, and the game lived up to the hype. Vivie Bojilov scored with 37 seconds left in the 4th quarter to lift the Hyacks past Centennial 35-33, in a battle of Top 3 teams in BC. Torsten Jaccard had a 2nd quarter to remember, with a TD run, an interception return for a major and a TD pass to Warren Reece. Nigel Eberding also scored for the Hyacks, who averaged 85 yards on each of their 4 scoring drives and finished with over 400 yards of offense. Brent Fletcher finished with 113 all-purpose yards and sealed the game with an interception. The Burger Haven Lineman of the Game was Rama McMillen



Defensively Casey Chin returned to his dominating

form with 11 tackles, **Shiraz Chaudhary** finished with 8. Bojilov returned to the defense as a rush end and recorded 7 tackles, a pair of sacks, and a devastating block on Jaccard's interception return. He also led all Hyacks with 78 yards along the ground. New West now 2-0 and will move into the #2 spot in the provincial rankings, the highest ranking they've ever held.

ANOTHER BIG BATTLE THIS FRIDAY IN ABBOTSFORD

The Hyacks highly competitive pre-season schedule continues this Friday when they take on #4 ranked WJ Mouat. The Hawks are among the favorites in the AAA Eastern division after winning the provincial JV championship last season. They opened 2009 with an impressive 41-14 win over their cross-town rivals from Rick Hansen, who are the top ranked team in AA.

The Hawks are led by Allan Dicks who finished with 171 yards on just 8 carries on Friday and his backfield mate Drew Chung. Tyler Declare anchors a stout defense. Many of the players on both teams were varsity starters in grade 10 when the two teams last met in the 2007 AAA Playoffs at BC Place with the Hyacks coming from behind to win 28-20.



JV's DEFEAT TERRY FOX IN OPENER

It was as good a start to the season as the Hyacks could have hoped for: a 26-8 win over perennial power Terry Fox on Thursday at Mercer Stadium. The home team jumped out to a 14-0 lead after the first quarter, 21-0 at half-time. **Regan Eberding** threw a pair of TD passes, one to TE **Jeremy Wilson** and another to **Ryan Schucroft**. Eberding also scored on a QB sneak. FB **Lucas London** scored the final TD. Wilson was dominant on both sides of the ball. All 40+ players who dressed for the Hyacks were able to play in the game. Hyacks are 1-0 and host Mission next Thursday at 5:30 at Mercer Stadium.

It was not a winning weekend for the youth teams, as all six fell in their weekend games against tough opponents.

The peewee black team gave the Cloverdale Lynx a run for their money but eventually lost 28-6. **Taylor Jensen** and **Jamie Shiho** led the offense by the outstanding blocking of **Sarban Sidhu**.

The junior bantam orange team lost 33-13 to the Vancouver Trojans. **Tommy Robertson** was an outstanding leader on both offense and defense, with **Marc Massicotte** also having a strong game. **Ryan Walia, Gurshawn Bains** and **Gurveer Dhaliwal** were also strong defensively.

The junior bantam black could fare no better against the host Cloverdale Cougars, falling 32-0. **Mackenzie Ratcliffe** led the Hyacks offense on both the ground and through the air, completing passes to **Ryan Rickaby** and **Jonathan Cote**. Rickaby and **Tristan Clayton** also had interceptions for the Hyacks.
