NUMBER ONE RANKED TEAM IN BC VISITS MERCER

The WJ Mouat Hawks, ranked number one in BC, will open the home campaign at Mercer Stadium this Friday night at 7 pm. This will be the first game of the season for the Hawks, who have reached the past 2 Subway Bowl provincial championship games.

The two teams staged a classic battle last September with New West coming out on top 36-33. Torsten Jaccard set a school record passing for 261 yards in that game. Daniel English caught 9 passes for 161 yards, both also school records.

WJ Mouat will be led by and outstanding QB in Cam Bedore and a deep receiving corps featuring by John Watson. Please note the new early 7 pm start times for all Hyack home games in September.

HYACKS LOSE OPENER IN OREGON

The Hyacks opened the season with a 40-0 loss at the hands of Kennedy HS of Mt Angel, OR. The Trojans are ranked #3 in the state at the 3A classification and lost in last years State championship game. It was the first time the Hyacks have been shutout since the 2006 season. Turnovers were the Hyacks undoing as they fumbled the ball 5 times. Early penalties also nullified some long runs which could have changed the game in the first quarter.

The Hyacks rushed for 186 yards led by 68 from David Ramirez, who also finished with 7 tackles and was named the Prime Time Player of the week. Ian Henderson led New West with 10 tackles. Jamie
