HOMECOMING THIS FRIDAY NIGHT

All Hyack Football Alumni, this is the game you have all been waiting for! The 6th annual Homecoming game will take place this Friday, Sept 17th at Mercer Stadium against the Terry Fox Ravens. Another crowd of 1500+ is expected to be on hand including plenty of Hyack grads from all eras. New West has recorded a perfect 5-0 record in homecoming games, but Terry Fox will provide a much stiffer challenge than the Hyacks have faced in the previous first five games.

The 2nd ranked Ravens are 2-0 this season, following a 19-14 win over then #2 ranked Vancouver College. They won the Subway Bowl provincial title in 2008, before losing to the Hyacks 23-12 in the quarter finals last season. The Ravens are led by QB/DB Cam Canales, who is among the best athletes playing football in BC.

This year's festivities include a special half-time performance by a local marching band and the NWSS Cheer team will also make its debut. James Belgrave led the attack with 126 yards and a TD. **Ian Henderson** had 100 yards and 8 tackles, while **Regan Eberding** scored 2 TDs and added 6 tackles.
