HYACKS FALL TO JUGGLERS



The Hyacks were unable to follow up last week's performance with another win this past Friday, falling 28-14 to Notre Dame at Burnaby Lake. After the jugglers got on the board with a pair of first quarter TDs, QB **Serafino Gentile** got the Hyacks back in it with a 2 yd QB sneak (#8 pictured left). In the 2nd half **James Belgrave** turned in an electrifying 83 yard kickoff return for a TD, his 2nd long return of the game. He also finished with 60 yards rushing, **Ian Henderson** and **Manraj Bains** each added 50 yards.



Defensively Henderson continued his dominating play, with a career-high 16 tackles, just one away from the school's single game record. He currently leads the

conference with 56 tackles and is ranked 3rd in BC. **Clay Alexson** added 7 tackles while **Jamie Wandell** had his best defensive game of the year with 6. In his only game of the year, **Brandon Braich** (#5 pictured right) also added 6 stops. With the loss, the Hyacks drop to 2-2 in conference play.
