SENIORS NIGHT THIS FRIDAY



This Friday will be the final time that 15 graduating seniors take to the field at Mercer Stadium wearing a Hyacks uniform. The list includes, **Nick Adomat**, **Clay Alexson**, **Brandon Braich** and **Jamie Wandell**, who have been with the Hyacks since Jr Bantam. Names like **Manraj Bains**, **Ian Henderson** and **David Ramirez** joined the program in JV. In terms of longtime Hyacks, the group is a small one, but filled with ability and character. The newer players have also provided an invaluable roll either in games or practice.

The players and the parent/guardians who have supported them, not just as football players but as students and young men for the past 17 years will also be recognized prior to the game, in what has become a very special tradition in the Hyacks program. PLAYOFF SPOT ON THE LINE IN SEASON FINALE

New West will take on Earl Marriott this Friday in the final game of the regular season. A win would improve the team's league record to 3-3 and virtually clinch a playoff spot. The Mariners are still looking for their first league win this year and fell to the Hyacks last year at Mercer 64-6. Kickoff is at 7:30 pm.

The Hyacks are hoping to get back into the win column after a disappointing 34-21 loss at Carson Graham last Friday. Despite the loss, **Ian Henderson** continued his outstanding play this season with 14 tackles and a blocked kick on defense along with 81 yards and a TD on offense. He currently leads the province in tackles with 76. **James Belgrave** added 129 yards and 2 TDs. **Manraj Bains** added 84 yards. Defensively, **Jamie Wandell** finished with 6 tackles and a blocked kick.

If the Hyacks advance to the playoffs, the game would be played on Saturday, Nov 13th at UBC's Thunderbird Stadium (time TBA).
