Varsity News & Notes

HYACKS MOVE INTO FIRST PLACE WITH WIN

NWSS rushed for a school record 452 yards on 36 carries in a 41-20 win over Carson Graham on Friday night at Mercer Stadium. The Hyacks scored on their first 4 possessions to take a 28-0 lead after the first quarter. **John Drury** led the way for the Hyacks, rushing for 118 yards and 3 TDs on just 6 carries in the first half. The 3 TDs ties the Hyacks record for TDs in a game (Ingram Jaccard vs North Surrey in 2004). **Darnell Sikorski** added 100 yards on 4 carries and **Blain Cawkell** finished with 90 yards and 1 TD on 7 carries. Grade 10 QB **Torsten Jaccard** scored his first varsity TD from a yard out and FB **Vivie Bojilov** scored the Hyacks last TD of the night (16 yds) in the fourth quarter. He also led the team with 6 tackles defensively. In all, the Hyacks used nine different ball carriers on the night.

New West improves to 3-1 in conference play (5-2 overall) and moves back into first place in the AAA Western Conference. Their next league game will be on Fri, Oct 26th against Mt Douglas HS in a game that could decide first place in the AAA Western Conference.

Eberding led all rushers with 98 yards on just 6 carries and opened the scoring on a 34 yard run. QB **Torsten Jaccard** called his own number from 13 yards out to make it 14-0 after the first quarter. Jaccard was also a perfect 4-for-4 for 101 yards passing. **Milton Nevy** scored his first TD as a Hyack and **Steve Ferdinandi** scored a TD and was a perfect 6-for-6 kicking PATs.

Defensively **Casey Chin** finished with a game-high 5 tackles. The JVs improve to 3-1 in conference play (4-2 overall). Next up for the JV Hyacks will be a huge game against Mt Douglas this Thursday at Mercer Stadium. *Please note the earlier 3:45 pm start time.*

As time ran down in the half, QB **Thomas Tse** completed a 6-yard TD pass to **Gavin Thind** and converted the score on a running play. The third quarter saw the visitors strike again, as Earl

followed some strong blocking on a counter play to score from 12 yards out. Richmond's lone score came on a short punt return deep in our end Many boys shone on both sides of the ball in this game, including **Lucas London**, **Luca Cirillo**, **Gavin Thind**, **Caleb Bogle** and **Connor Brady**.
