2008 SEASON IN REVIEW



For the second consecutive year, the Varsity Hyacks reached the Provincial AAA Semi-finals, before falling to the eventual provincial champions from Terry Fox at Burnaby Lake Sports Complex. New West finished the year with an overall 8-3 record (4-1 in league play). Also for the 2nd straight year, the Hyacks' offence led the province in rushing with over 3500 yards and finished with an impressive 52 TDs.

Three grade 11 players were named to the Gatorade Provincial All-star team (Casey Chin, Daniel English and Rama MacMillan) while three of our all-conference seniors are expected to be playing college football next fall: TE

Tyler Digby will be attending Robert Morris University in Pittsburgh (NCAA Div 1), FB Blain Cawkell is being recruited by St Mary's, Bishops, SFU, Calgary, Acadia and UBC. The two local universities are also recruiting DB Marko Susic.

For the JVs it was a rebuilding year. The group that finished the season worked extremely hard to learn the game and improved every week. The coaching staff is very excited to work with this group over the next 2-3 years and is fully expecting they will continue the excellence that has been

established by the classes ahead of them. Thanks to Coach Oatway for another job well done.

The youth program continued to make strides in 2008. Coach Leslie oversaw both the Pee Wee and Jr Bantam teams and as a result we saw a positive attitude, a committed coaching staff and tremendous parental support. The players had fun, learned plenty and have established a solid foundation for future championships at both the youth and high school levels.

PREPARATIONS FOR 2009 SEASON UNDERWAY

With the vast majority of the varsity roster returning in 2009, the upcoming season promises to be the best ever for the Hyack Football program. Players have already begun working out, with the formal portion of the off-season program set to begin on January 5th. Coach Oatway will again be in charge of the off-season strength and conditioning program and will meet with returning and new players to hand out program and nutrition information as well as go through weight room expectations, base exercises and proper and safe lifting techniques.

The weight program is split into three five-week phases focused on growth, strength and power to best prepare the players for spring training in May and June. During the first two weeks of January, the players will undergo "base-line" testing in the weight room, giving the athletes and coaches a concrete number against which to track progress throughout the spring. We ask that players try to work out with their position groups wherever possible, as follows:

- Monday and Wednesday: Lineman & Inside Linebackers
- Tuesday and Thursday: Backs, Receivers & Outside Linebackers
- Friday: Open weight room for all positions

Off-season schedules and goal setting sheets will be emailed to all players over the winter break. Varsity players will also need to schedule an individual meeting with Coach Lalji before the end of the semester.
