HYACKS TO PLAY TERRY FOX IN QUARTER FINALS

If the Hyacks are to become provincial champions this season, the first step will be to knock off the defending provincial champs, Terry Fox, this Friday night at McLeod Stadium in Langley. The Ravens advanced to face the Hyacks thanks to a 48-14 win over Carson Graham in the wildcard round last week. New West enters the game following a bye week as a result of their 2nd place finish in the Western conference.

The Ravens began the season as the number one ranked team in BC. After their 16 game win streak came to an end in early October, the Hyacks took over top spot in the provincial rankings. Currently New West is ranked 3rd in BC after a 9-1 regular season (4-1 in league play), while the Ravens are ranked 5th with an 8-2 record (3-2 in league play). Terry Fox defeated New West twice last season, including a win in the provincially semi-finals.

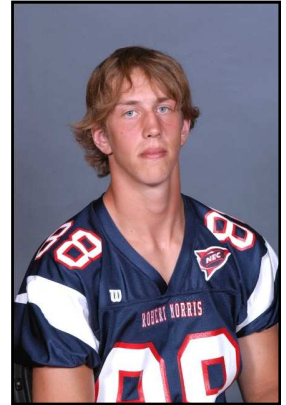
DIGBY SCORES FIRST TD IN NCAA

Congratulations to NWSS grad, Tyler Digby, who scored his first TD for Robert Morris University (NCAA Div 1) on his first reception this past Saturday. Digby, a true Freshman, scored on a 24 yard pass to give the Colonials a 24-10 lead, en route to a 37-10 win over first place Wagner University. This was the 4th straight for RMU who are now 4-3 in conference play.

Tyler has been travelling and playing regularly on special teams in his first season in Pittsburgh. He was a 3-year varsity starter at NWSS and graduated in 2009 with school records for TD receptions (12) and sacks (13), earning all-conference honors a year ago.
