### HYACKS KNOCK OFF DEFENDING PROVINCIAL CHAMPS



The Hyacks storybook season continues as the team knocked off the defending AAA provincial champions, Terry Fox, 23-12, in a quarter final playoff game at McLeod Stadium in Langley on Friday. **Vivie Bojilov**, **Shiraz Chaudhary** and **Warren Reece** each scored for the Hyacks. **Nigel Eberding** picked a good time for his best game of the season, rushing for a season-high 130 yards on 10 carries, including a 2-point convert, and also was impressive on defense with 7 tackles and a forced fumble. **Torsten Jaccard** threw the game's opening TD pass and did an outstanding job of leading and managing the game.

**Casey Chin** led the way defensively with 16 tackles, just 1 off the school single-game record.

Bojilov (11 tackles, 1 sack), Chaudhary (7 tackles, 1 fumble recovery) also stood out on defense. The defensive line, led by **Mohit Johal**, **Russell Birosh**, **Ryan Noble** and **Ian Henderson** was also impressive. **Brent Fletcher** set a new school record with his 6<sup>th</sup> interception of the season.

It was an especially sweet moment for the seniors who have had their past 2 seasons ended by Terry Fox. The Hyacks are now 10-1 on the season, the 2<sup>nd</sup> time they have reached the 10-win plateau since resurrecting the football program at NWSS 7 years ago.

### HYACKS TAKE ON NUMBER ONE RANKED TEAM IN SEMIS

The Centennial Centaurs will provide the opposition as the Hyacks will play in the provincial semi-finals for the 3<sup>rd</sup> straight year. Centennial remains the number one ranked team in BC, following a 48-20 win over Lord Tweedsmuir in the quarter finals on Saturday.

The Centaurs are 9-1 on the season, with their only loss coming to New West, 35-33 back on Sept 11<sup>th</sup>. They are led by provincial player of the year Lemar Durant, who was moved from WR to QB 6 weeks ago. Nehemie Kankolongo is another key player the Hyacks must contain.

The game kicks off at 5:30 pm at McLeod Stadium in Langley (on 216<sup>th</sup>, next to the Langley airport). # FOUR HYACKS EARN PROVINCIAL ALL-STAR HONORS

## **Vivie Bojilov** **Defensive Player of the Year**

Vivie is among the province's leaders in tackles with 66 and 4 sacks, along with currently sitting 2<sup>nd</sup> in BC with 1384 rushing yards and 13 TDs. He is the first Hyack to be named Provincial Defensive Player of the Year.


From Coach Lalji, "Vivie has had an outstanding season for us on both sides of the ball. Week after week, he proved he is one of the best players in this province. It is rare to find someone who can combine his strength, speed and athleticism."



## **\* Casey Chin** **Linebacker**

Casey is currently 3<sup>rd</sup> in BC with 94 tackles and will likely be the first Hyack ever to break the 100 mark in a season. His 183 career tackles is also a school record.

From Coach Lalji: "You couldn't ask for more in a linebacker and leader than what Casey brings to our team. He is an explosive hitter and has tremendous instincts. He rarely ever makes a mistake and is at his best when the game is on the line."



## **\* Rama MacMillan** **Offensive Line**

Rama was also named the top linemen in the conference and plays a key role on an offense that has racked up almost 5000 yards and 60 TDs.

From Coach Lalji: "Rama is very athletic for such a big man. Watching him keep up with our running backs downfield on long runs is very impressive and intimidating for the opposition. He has improved as much as anyone in our program over the past 4 years."



## **\* Daniel English** **Receiver**

Daniel has close to 1100 all-purpose yards this season and 9 TDs. He is a 3-year starter who currently holds 5 NWSS receiving records.

From Coach Lalji: "Daniel is an exceptional athlete and a game breaker for us. He is a player defenses have to give special attention to every week. Even in games when he doesn't get enough touches he finds a way to make an impact."

The last time the Hyacks had 4 provincial all stars was in 2005. No other school received more than four all stars. Also receiving votes was Brent Fletcher. Congratulations to all of these players on an outstanding season thus far.

## JACCARD EARNS PROVINCIAL SCHOLARSHIP



Torsten Jaccard will be recognized at the provincial all-star awards banquet, earning one of 10 BCSSFA provincial scholarships. The Sr QB is closing in on the 1000 yard passing mark on the season. He has thrown for 12 TDs, rushed for 4 TDs, and returned an interception for another. He also set a school single game passing record with 261 yards vs Mouat.

All of that comes while maintaining a 4.0 GPA in a highly competitive academic course load. Torsten is the 3<sup>rd</sup> Hyack to earn one of these coveted provincial scholarships - the first was his brother Ingram in 2004. The award is given for outstanding academic and athletic achievement, along with leadership and citizenship. Matthew Mussenden was also a finalist for one of these awards. Congrats Torsten, this is well deserved!

## JV SEASON COMES TO AN END

The JV Hyacks had a great season even as they entered the year's season with a number of question marks. A core of solid players were returning, with a good group of great athletes coming into the program for the first time. Unfortunately on Thursday night in the quarter finals, that lack of football experience caught up with the JV's as they fell to St. Thomas Moore. In an ugly, windy night the JV's fought, but couldn't overcome the constant blitzes of the Knights defense. Although there was some tough running by **Connor Brady** and **Lucas London** behind some great blocks by **Derek Stagner** on offense, and some great defensive plays by **Makoto Brennen** and **Ben Senemoglu** the Hyacks couldn't match the offense put up by the Knights. A few JV's will now move up and help the Varsity squad on their march through the playoffs.
